

**Second Call for Papers
3rd of February 2009**

Dear Colleagues,

I am pleased to announce you some novelties regarding the workshop we are organising in Craiova (Romania) on the 7th-9th of May 2009.

First of all, I wanted to thank you all for the interest shown towards our workshop. The organisers have tried to adjust the main themes to all possible research fields regarding the Spanish Golden Age, as it follows:

**The importance of Lope's *Arte Nuevo de Hacer Comedias en este tiempo*
Lope de Vega's Theatre
The Theatre in the Spanish Golden Age
The Mystical and Ascetic Literature in the Spanish Golden Age
The Prose in the Spanish Golden Age
The Poetry in the Spanish Golden Age
The History of the Spanish Golden Age
The Art in the Spanish Golden Age
The Translation of the Texts from Spanish Golden Age
The Teaching of the Texts form the Spanish Golden Age**

The workshop's languages are Spanish and English.

We must also take into consideration that the main reason of our workshop is the celebration of 400 years since the publication of Lope's *Arte Nuevo*. Hence, we decided to dedicate a special section to this important poetics, which had an important influence over the European manner of writing theatre from that moment on. **Felipe Pedraza** (Universidad de Castilla La Mancha), one of our key speakers, will hold a conference about *El Arte Nuevo*.

The other key speakers will be held by **María Luisa Lobato** (Universidad de Burgos), **Begoña Fernández Cabaleiro** (Universidad Autónoma de Madrid), **Luis Jambrina** (Universidad de Salamanca) and **Ileana Scipione** (Universitatea “Spiru Haret”, Bucharest).

The other papers presented will not exceed 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes of debates.

The Manuscript Submission:

The manuscripts should not exceed 30.000 characters, including the notes and bibliography. They will be written with TNR 12, with a space of 1.5 and with margins of 2 cm. The paper size must be B5 ISO or ENVELOPE. Footnotes will be used written with TNR 10, as it follows:
